### First Communication

In October you will receive the first written communication, which will include comments and observations about your child's learning and behavior.

### First Report Card

The first report card will be sent home with your child during the week of **November 23, 2017**. The report card will cover the period from August 31, 2017 to November 23, 2017 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

### Second Report Card

The second report card will be sent home with your child during the week of **February 23, 2018**. The report card will cover the period from November 14, 2017 to February 6, 2018 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

### Third Report Card

The third report card will be sent home to you, prior to **June 22, 2018**. It will cover the period from February 7, 2018 to June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 and will count for 60% of the student's final mark. The final marks for all subjects will be indicated on this report card.
